SCHOOL SPONSORED ACTIVITIES AND TRIPS

Students traveling on an approved school sponsored trip must travel to the event and return from the event with their designated group. Exceptions to these policies will be considered by the Activity Director and Principal prior to the trip. Appropriate student behavior is essential to provide a safe and meaningful experience for all involved in school sponsored activities and trips.

The following policies will be strictly enforced by the activity supervisor and designated chaperones:

- 1. Students shall not possess or use weapons, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or drug paraphernalia.
- 2. Students shall not engage in disturbing behavior on the activity bus or at any school activity.
- 3. Students will report promptly and prepare for all activities and bus schedules.
- 4. Students shall not visit any areas except those designated by the supervisor.
- 5. Students will be assigned to rooms on overnight trips.
- 6. Students shall adhere to curfews as established by the supervisor.
- 7. Students shall not leave a lodging accommodation, activity area, or any other group activity without the permission of the supervisor.
- 8. Students will be responsible for paying the cost of any damaged property.
- 9. Students will dress to reflect the occasion.
- 10. Initiations of any kind are strictly forbidden.
- 11. Students shall not engage in behavior that endangers, embarrasses, harasses, or violates the rights of others.
- 12. Students' rooms, luggage, and personal belongings are subject to periodic inspection by the supervisor or designee as deemed necessary to insure the enforcement of these policies.
- 13. Disciplinary action shall be taken for the violation of any of the above policies. The the supervisor will take appropriate disciplinary action depending upon the frequency or severity of the violation. If the supervisor determines that a violation of these policies is intolerable or severe, a student will be returned or sent home at parent/guardian expense prior to the completion of the activity or trip.
- 14. The activity or trip supervisor, Activity Director, and/or Principal will determine the number of chaperones necessary for an activity or trip.
